## Supply List

### September 19, 20, and 21, 2008

A large wet palette system and Sta-Wet Palette paper that is approximately 10" X 15" or larger (such as the larger Masterson Sta-Wet Palette systems). If you do not have the large Masterson Stay Wet Palette system, you can improvise by using a large baking or cookie pan from your cupboard...or purchase a large disposable aluminum cookie sheet from the grocery store. You will need a layer that can hold moisture underneath your palette paper in the tray. You can use several layers of heavy shop towels or a large sheet of "shammy" type material for the wet layer to hold water underneath your Sta-Wet palette paper.

- A large water basin or container: (the size of a large cool whip container or coffee can
- Newspapers or plastic to cover your table area while painting
- Paper Towels;
- Hair Dryer
- Black and White Graphite Paper with a pen or Stylus for transferring patterns
- Painter's or masking tape
- Canvasses:
  - **Open House 16X20**
  - **Wine country 16X20**
  - **Breanna on the Beach 14X18**
- Easel of your choice
- Brushes and painting tools: Bring all your favorite brushes ...to include the **Royal/Langnickel Brushes** (mostly **Soft Grip Brushes**) listed below or some similar to them. Having more than one of each type and size of brush is often handy, so you may want to bring your duplicates as well.

Background brush = 2" bristle flat (hardware type brush or Royal L280 size 2")

- Bristle flats = #12, #6, & #2; (will need a large, medium and small flat bristle brush)
- Round bristle = #12 SG400R
- Fan bristle = #2 SG405FB
- Liner = #0 synthetic SG 585
- Flat synthetic detail = #4 SG150
- Comb = ½" synthetic SG730
- Mop or Hake= ¾" SG 1400
- Angle = ½" Synthetic # SG 160
- Round synthetic = #2 SG252 - 2
- Crooked handled Palette & Painting Knife
- Small sea wool sponge size
